

PROPOSED OBJECTIVES FOR COMMUNITY-WIDE OPINION RESEARCH JUNE 24, 2015

- 1. Give the township board and planning commission useful information to guide their decisions.
- 2. Broadly determine whether the residents of Northfield Township want more residential development in the township and measure the strength of their opinions.
- 3. To guide planning, identify which features of an ideal future township are the most important to residents.
- 4. Determine if and how the respondents' location affects their opinions.
- 5. Determine how the possible location of residential development affects opinions.
- 6. Determine the relative strength of opinions regarding how people perceive they might benefit from development.
- 7. Determine the relative strength of opinions about what is good for the community.
- 8. Identify other reasons why people oppose or support more development.
- 9. Determine if and how demographic status (age, income, education, gender) affect opinions.
